How to get to the Princess Royal Hospital (PRH) in Telford

Where is the Princess Royal Hospital?

The Princess Royal Hospital is located on the A5223 in northern Telford.

Travelling by Car

The Princess Royal Hospital is signposted from major road routes including Junction 6 of the M54.

The postcode is TF1 6TF (suitable for SatNav systems).


Other routes, including the B5061 via Atcham, provide alternatives for non-motorway traffic.

Travelling by Public Transport

The Princess Royal Hospital has a bus stop near to the main entrance. There are frequent bus services from Telford Bus and Train Stations and Wellington Bus Station (close to Wellington Train Station).




Train stations are situated in Wellington & Telford, with local bus service routes to the Princess Royal Hospital.

How to pay to park

Patients and visitors should pay on arrival at the PRH. You should pay a fee which is enough to cover the anticipated length of your visit. The hospital can be very busy so please allow plenty of time before your appointment to park. The car parks are managed on our behalf by CP Plus. Please talk to the CP Plus car parking attendants if you are having difficulty finding a space. A tiered charging structure is in operation, offering a range of rates for different lengths of stay. The tariffs include free parking for up to 30 minutes. If you park at RSH/PRH and then travel to the other site you will not have to pay again within the period you have paid for. If you arrive at PRH first, please pay for the duration of your stay and your displayed ticket will cover you for your visit to RSH for the period you have paid for. If you arrive at RSH first though a different system is in operation. You will need to use the pay-on-exit system and obtain a receipt from the car parking attendants. When you arrive at PRH please take your receipt to the car parking booth and the attendants will take note of your registration so you don't have to pay again for the duration of the visit you paid for at RSH. The charges are:

0 to 30mins - Free; 30mins to 2hrs - £2.50; 2hrs to 5hrs - £3.00; 5hrs up to 24hrs - £3.50; 10-visit ticket - £8.00.

Women and Children's Services: Changes at a glance

The Shropshire Women and Children's Centre will open at Princess Royal Hospital (PRH) in Telford from 29 September 2014, when it will become the main inpatient facility for children and women in Shropshire, Telford & Wrekin and mid Wales.

Shropshire Women and Children's Centre and PRH in Telford From 29 September, the following services will be based at the centre:

- Children's Inpatient and Assessment Services
- Children's Oncology and Haematology Services
- Children's Outpatients
- Gynaecology Inpatient, Emergencies, Procedures and Early Pregnancy Assessment Service

From 30 September, the following services will be based in the centre:

- Consultant-led Maternity Services
- Neonatal services

PRH will also continue to have its existing A&E, adult Outpatients and day case services, Children's Surgery, the Wrekin Midwife Led Unit, and Antenatal Appointments, Scans and Day Assessment.

Royal Shrewsbury Hospital

RSH will continue to have:

- Adult Day Case Services
- Midwife-led Maternity Services
- Antenatal Appointments and Scans
- Antenatal Day Assessment
- Women's Outpatient Services including Colposcopy
- Early Pregnancy Assessment Service
- Fertility Services
- Emergency department and other hospital services

Elsewhere

In addition to the services at PRH and RSH, there will continue to be Midwife Led Units in Bridgnorth, Ludlow and Oswestry, and women can choose to give birth at one of the Midwife Led Units run by Powys Teaching Health Board, or at home
