Self Help Tips for Cystitis

The Radiotherapy which you are receiving to your Pelvis may cause a side effect referred to as cystitis.

Cystitis is a burning sensation when passing urine. This is a normal reaction to the treatment.

You may be asked by the doctor or radiographers to give a urine sample, this is to rule out the possibility of there being an infection.

If you are suffering from cystitis then there are some measures you can take at home to ease the discomfort.

- Put a teaspoon of baking soda in a pint of water, taken once a day.
- Avoid caffeine (tea and coffee), acidic or spicy foods, citrus fruits, alcohol and chocolate.
- Drink half-a-pint of water every 20 minutes to flush bacteria out, (to a maximum of 3 litres daily) plus a daily glass of cranberry juice.
- To relieve the pain, take some of your normal painkillers at the dose stated on the packet.
- Go to the Chemist, Pharmacy or supermarket and ask for an overthe-counter remedy for Cystitis.
