CARDIO CALL ECG EVENT RECORDER – Patient Instructions
To record an ECG
<ol> <li>Press the metal <u>feet</u> to your bare chest, ensuring that all four <u>feet</u> are in direct contact with bare skin.</li> </ol>
2. Press and hold the GREEN (REC) button until you hear 3 beeps then a whistle.
3. Release the button and keep still until the whistle stops.
It is important to remain very still and relaxed during the recording,
You may record several recording before phoning the recording in. Once the
Memory is full, recording must be sent through to allow the recording of future events.
Important note-Memory full
As soon as Cardio Call is full of transmitted recordings, it will make a telephone ringer sound.
To send an ECG
This is done using a telephone receiving service. You many phone the recording(s) through at any
time; this is a 24 hour service.
When you are ready to send a recording please follow the following instructions.
1. Place the Cardio Call on a firm, flat surface.
2. Phone 01952 282896.
<ol><li>Please listen carefully to the instructions you will hear. You will be asked to leave your name, Hospital number and symptoms. Wait until you hear the message</li></ol>
4. THANK YOU FOR CALLING before transmitting the recording.
5. Now put the mouthpiece of the telephone over the speaker on the Cardio Call.
6. Press the YELLOW (Send) button until you hear a beep then release the button.
7. Leave the telephone mouthpiece against the Cardio Call until the Whistling sound stops then
hang up the telephone.
