Executive Summary

There has been an ongoing programme of engagement to support the development of a Travel and Transport Plan. This has included articles in the Trust's A Healthier Future newsletter (e.g. October 2011), discussion in public briefings and workshops and a discussion document ("Shaping Your Travel and Transport") to seek views.

Nearly 100 responses were received, with the main focus being on car parking arrangements at the Trust. A presentation on the feedback received during the consultation will be made to the Trust Board on 26 July 2012. This feedback from patients and the public will support the development of (a) a discussion document on staff travel and transport and (b) a detailed Travel and Transport Plan for future presentation to the Trust Board.
