

Entrance Closures at our Hospitals

For the protection of patients, the public and our staff, some of our public entrances are currently closed. All changes follow consultation with relevant centres and will be monitored for effectiveness and/or service impact.

Please note: staff are still able to access the buildings through the closed entrances by using codes. Please see the intranet for more information if this applies to you. Visitors are able to use intercoms where indicated.

Royal Shrewsbury Hospital Changes

- Ward Block Entrance: closed – intercom for those visiting End of Life patients
- Treatment Centre: Open from 7am-6pm *weekdays only*. Closed from 6pm-7pm Mon-Fri and all weekend.
- Surgical Assessment Unit: closed – intercom for patients
- Renal Unit Ambulatory Door: closed
- Door into Hummingbird Centre: Open from 8am-6pm *weekdays only*. Closed 6pm-8pm and over the weekend.
- Entrance to the Main Building next to Elizabeth House: closed
- AMA Patient & Relative Entrance: Closed – entry via Acute Medical Unit Entrance

Princess Royal Hospital Changes

- Main Entrance: Open 6.30am-7.30pm every day. Intercom for those visiting End of Life patients.
- Day Surgery Entrance: closed
- Women's and Children's: closed. Intercom for Patients and Partners.
- Doors into the main corridor at both sides of the hospitals (next to Wrekin MLU and the Discharge lounge: Closed
- Paul Brown Day Hospital: Closed
