2a	Alert	 BAF – The BAF is being reviewed line by line in June as this is overdue a complete update. CQC – Poor feedback received following recent unannounced visit and significant work needed. BAME Risk Assessments are at 86% and focus is being given to complete 100% assessments by end of June. Training – Statutory and mandatory training compliance rate has dropped by 1% during Covid. 		
2b	Assurance	 CQC – The Committee will receive a written monthly update on CQ related issues to monitor progress. Overseas nurses - Support to overseas nurses that remain in lockdow is a high priority and the use of technology such as Zoom to support mandatory training and OSCE preparations is being developed. Training – The Committee approved for Safeguarding Training separate this from the monthly Trust statutory report providing improve intelligence around this area. Diversity Strategy – The Committee positively received the Equality Diversity and Inclusivity Strategy which links in to the People Strategy and provides a forward plan. The Committee were the first to join a virtual Genba which was with the Cleanliness Technicians. They often feel invisible and overlooked and their comments will be shared with the Workforce Business Partners to provide support.
