2a	Alert	The Committee wish to alert members of the Board that:			
		The numbers of staff required to isolate continues to increase through September due to various factors including periods of household isolation due to a member of the household being symptomatic and staff being required to isolate due to test and trace. Although, 80% of staff absent due to household isolation return within 7 days with over 50% returning within 3 days indicating staff and households are referred quickly			
		In addition, absence related to mental health continues to be high with 32% of all non-covid sickness attributed to it which equates to 75 FTE. Workforce wellbeing is therefore a key focus area.			
		The Committee were provided with a verbal update on the flu vaccination program. The Committee were informed of some challenges with the on- line booking process which had been shared at the virtual Genba which had been conducted with HDU/ITU Departments at both RSH and PRH.			
2b	Assurance	The Committee wish to assure members of the Board that:			
		A verbal update was provided regarding the continued support which the Trust is providing to our Overseas Nurses. The Trust has also been approached by other Trusts as an exemplar of the Overseas recruitment and onboarding process.
