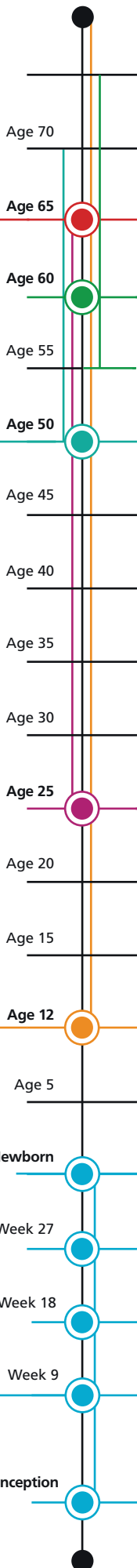
## AAA screening

### Abdominal aortic aneurysm

Offered to **men** during the **year they turn 65**. Older men can self-refer

## Bowel Cancer Screening

Offered to **men and women** aged **60 to 74 every 2 years**. Those aged 75 or over can request screening by calling **0800 7076060**.

In some parts of the county people **aged 55** are also invited for a one-off bowel scope screening test.

## Breast Screening

- **newborn** and infant physical examination (for problems with eyes, hearts, hips and testes)
- **newborn** blood spot (for 9 rare conditions)

- sickle cell and thalassaemia
- infectious diseases in **pregnancy** (for HIV, hepatitis B and syphilis)
