Executive summary:	<ul> <li>Key points to note by exception:</li> <li>Overall performance in relation to many of the IPC KPIs remains positive, with the improvement targets for C.Diff and MSSA achieved in Quarter 1 of 2021/2022.</li> <li>One MRSA bacteraemia in May 2021 considered to be a contaminant</li> <li>There were no cases COVID nosocomial infections</li> <li>Staff compliance for Lateral Flow Screening is low; improvement needed</li> <li>There was one IPC Serious Incident in Quarter 1, this related to decontamination of Transrectal (TRUS) Prostate Biopsy probe</li> <li>The Outcome of the NHSE/I IPC review which took place in July was positive with the Trust rated as green.</li> <li>The NHSE/I IPC BAF is updated monthly, the Trust is RAG rated green for 100 of the key lines of enquiry and amber for the remaining 9 items</li> <li>The Trust Self-Assessment against the Hygiene Code (the Health and Social Care Act 2008) shows the Trust is 96.9% compliant</li> </ul>
