Site progress of new healthcare facilities at Royal Shrewsbury Hospital

Dear neighbour,

We are writing to provide you with an update on the Hospitals Transformation Programme (HTP) and construction of the new healthcare facilities at Royal Shrewsbury Hospital, HTP is a key part of the overarching plan to transform and improve health and care services for our communities.

Construction update

In December, the project reached an important construction milestone where we gathered with staff, project partners and community members to mark the topping-out of the building. This means the four-storey expansion has now reached the highest point in all four construction areas. We are now moving into the next stage of construction and will focus on internal works, fitting out clinical spaces and completing the landscaping surrounding the new entrance.

Next phase of Emergency Department refurbishment and expansion

We will soon be relocating the two-storey modular building in front of the Emergency Department (ED), highlighted in grey on the below site map to the area highlighted in blue on the site map.

This is so we can continue with the progress we are making to expand the existing ED and create our new emergency care department and dedicated children's emergency care footprint, ready for 2028.

Our contractors, Integrated Health Projects, are preparing the site this week ready to start groundworks for the building relocation (highlighted in blue) on Monday 19 January. We hope to complete the building relocation in spring. We are working on several options to see how best to use this building in the future and we will keep you updated as these plans progress.

Site map detailing building relocation



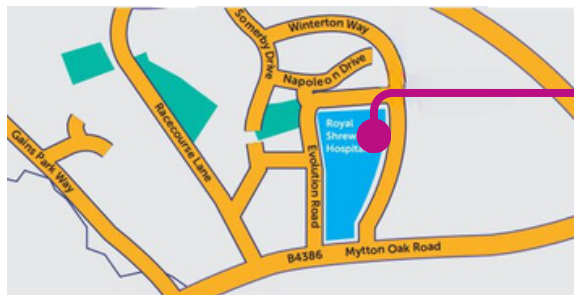
We also wanted to share that we are hoping to bring a modular theatre to RSH. We are in the early stages of this project and will share more information with you on this project as soon as we are able to.

Parking update

We know that parking continues to be a concern for our neighbours, particularly with the large volume of construction activity currently underway at RSH. Please be assured that in the long term we are working on several solutions to improve this and maximise our estate as much as possible. This includes:

- Opening a near-by offsite car park on Mytton Oak Road with a mixture of staff and contractor parking, providing additional spaces
- Works have been completed to provide additional spaces at the front of the site near the Copthorne building
- In the coming months, we will also be demolishing some of our old, unusable estate near Stretton House. This will allow us to develop more spaces adjacent to existing car parks
